

**TOWN OF ARGOS
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
WEDNESDAY, April 6, 2016**

CALL TO ORDER:

Council President Dustin Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:39 PM.

ROLL CALL:

Present for the meeting: President Dustin Johnson, Vice President George Null, Members Juli Stauffer, Suzanne Umbaugh, Charles R Snead, Clerk-Treasurer Lisa Mullaney and Attorney Fred Jones.

MINUTES:

Minutes from the March 16th Regular Session were submitted for approval. Vice President Null moved to accept the minutes and Member Stauffer seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

CITIZEN INPUT:

No citizen input but Member Umbaugh recognized Mr. Jim Burroughs for his 30 years of service to the town. T.A.S.K.: Presentation
